# A Bit of Quality Background



## **HEDIS (Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set)**

The term HEDIS originated in the late 1980's as the product of a group of forward-thinking employers and quality experts. It is a set of widely used performance indicators which provide health care consumers and purchasers with valuable and reliable information to compare the performance of health plans.



## **NCQA (National Committee for Quality Assurance)**

HEDIS is developed and maintained by NCQA and is used by more than 90% of the US health plans to measure health care quality and service.

# Pediatric Immunizations

## Immunizations for Adolescents (Combo 2) (IMA)

Adolescents who have had the following immunizations by their 13th birthday:

- One dose of meningococcal vaccine and
- One tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine and
- Completed the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine series

One meningococcal vaccine between the 11<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday

One Tdap vaccine between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday

At least three HPV vaccinations between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthday OR  
At least two HPV vaccines between the member's 9<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> birthdays

### Coding:

Meningococcal: 90734

Tdap: 90715

HPV: 90649-90651

The claim for each vaccine administered must include the vaccination supply code in addition to the administration code

Vaccine codes: Refer to NYS Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program

# Pediatric Immunizations continued

## Childhood Immunizations Status (vaccination combo 3) (CIS)

Children 2 years of age who have had the following immunizations on or before their second birthday:

- 4 diphtheria, tetanus, and acellular pertussis (DTaP)
- 3 polio (IPV)
- 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella)
- 3 haemophilus influenza type B (HiB)
- 3 hepatitis B (HepB)
- 1 chicken pox (VZV)
- 4 pneumococcal conjugate (PCV)

**Above immunizations  
should be completed prior  
to the 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday**

### Coding:

The claim for each vaccine administered must include the vaccination supply code in addition to the administration code

Vaccine codes: **Refer to NYS Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program**

# Pediatric Well Checks

## Well Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life (W30)/ revised measure as of 7/2020

1. Well-Child Visits in the First 15 months – Five or more well-child visits
2. Well-Child Visits for Age 15 Months-30 Months – Two or more well-child visits

- Five or more well-child visits before the 15-month birthday
- Two or more well-child visits between the child's 15-month birthday and the 30-month birthday

### Coding:

99381-99382, 99391-99392, 99461

# Pediatric Well Checks

## Child and Adolescent Well Child Visits (WCV)/ revised measure as of 7/2020

Children 3-17 years of age with one well-child visit with a PCP or an OBGYN practitioner within the calendar year

- One or more well-child visits per year

### Coding:

99382-99385, 99392-99395

## Pediatric Weight Assessment and Counseling (WCC)

### Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity for Children/ Adolescents (WCC)

Children 3-17 years of age who had an outpatient visit with a PCP or OB/ GYN practitioner and who had evidence of the following:

- BMI percentile documentation
- Counseling for nutrition
- Counseling for physical activity
- All 3 components need to be met to get credit for the measure
- Can be supplemented with chart review

It is recommended a child receive weight assessment and counseling for nutrition and physical activity at least once per year during each of their 3<sup>rd</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> years of life

**\*\* Counseling for Nutrition and Counseling for Physical Activity indicators do not require a specific setting. Therefore, services rendered during a *telephone visit, e-visit or virtual check-in* meet criteria**

BMI percentile: Z68.51, Z68.52, Z68.53, Z68.54

Nutrition Counseling: Z71.3  
97802-97804; G0270-G0271

Physical Activity Counseling: Z71.82, Z02.5  
G0447

**\*\* Ensure *all* diagnosis codes submitted are also included in the medical record**

## Additional tips

- Modifier 25 - significant, separately identifiable Evaluation and Management (E/M) service by the same physician or other qualified health care professional on the same day of a procedure or other service.
- Acute visits can be added at time of well checks
- Well checks/ Immunization catch up at time of acute visit
- Modifier 25 is applied to E/M code (but may also be needed on WCV code based additional codes billed and on payor guidelines)

# Dental Visits

## Annual Dental Visit (ADV)

Patients 2-20 years of age who had at least one dental visit during the calendar year

**One or more dental visits  
with a dental practitioner  
during the calendar year**

### Coding:

Any visit/ claim with a dental practitioner during the calendar year meets criteria
